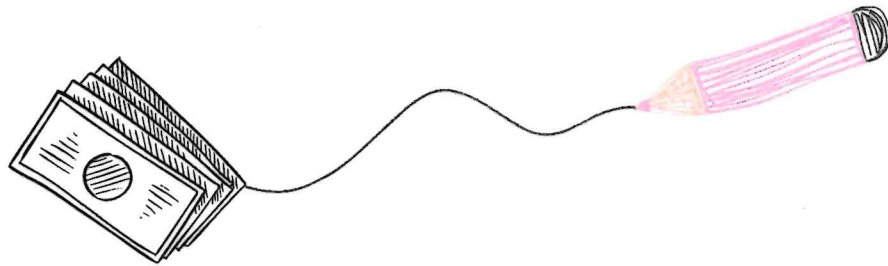


Get Started

Join School Banking! Designed to teach children the importance of saving

BayCoast Bank's School Banking program is designed to give students the opportunity to learn the basics of saving money directly from our BayCoast Bank staff members. The program is a great way to introduce kids to the exciting world of banking and to get them comfortable interacting with bank staff as they learn how to save.

Here's how it works:



Bank representatives visit your child's school on a regularly scheduled "Banking Day" each month to help students open accounts, make deposits and answer banking questions.



We'll mail a receipt to the child's home after each banking day. At the end of each month, an official bank statement will be mailed to the child's address provided at account opening.



Students learn first-hand how to save money and how banks work while having the opportunity to speak with bank staff in person on a regular basis about the importance of saving money.

Here's how parents and guardians can get involved:

1 Gather all the necessary information outlined on the reverse form and bring to a bank representative so that we may open your child's account.

2 Start to think of some creative and fun ways that your child can earn money and encourage them to build healthy saving habits using their account.

3 On school banking day, send your child to school with their journal and deposit (cash or check made payable to BayCoast Bank) and we will take care of the rest!
