#### Massachusetts CORI Check - Need to Complete for Volunteers

CORI training is online at <a href="https://fallriver.cmgconnect.org">https://fallriver.cmgconnect.org</a>. CORI law is clear that every school is required to obtain CORI on any volunteers every year. If you want to volunteer to be a chaperone, coach, or any other activity that involves students you must complete this procedure to ensure compliance. Valid identification must be provided with all completed forms: CORI Acknowledgment form, Code of Conduct form, and online training (CMG) printed certificate.
