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Our Diocese has a wonderful tradition of making every effort to support Catholic Education, and in particular to assist families who struggle to afford tuition for their children.

To assist families with tuition, a parish subsidy system was set up, where those who were active members of a parish could apply for some financial aid from the parish, which is typically \$300 per student.

This subsidy is given on a case by case basis directly from the pastor to families who are actively participating in the life of the parish, meaning that they are attending Holy Mass each Sunday and Holy Days and taking part in parish activities. Parish subsidy is given on a yearly basis.

If you belong to another parish, but have your child(ren) enrolled at St. Michael's, you can ask your pastor to sign this form and your parish will give you the subsidy.

Please see me before or after school, or at Church to sign each form. For financial planning purposes, ALL FORMS must be signed and turned in no later than June 1, 2018. No application will be accepted after June 1.
